

#5: OVER AND UNDER

Secret Ingredients: Stack (and Monster)

Presentation: Teams are given a single page, printed front and back with a four-by-four grid of squares. Each side of each square contains a picture or a word, plus a letter of the alphabet. Text and dotted lines indicate that the pictures should be cut out.

Solution: Each word pairs with a picture to clue a phrase linked by the word “over” or “under”. For example, the phrase “somewhere OVER the rainbow” is clued by the word “somewhere” and a picture of a rainbow.

These phrases indicate how to properly arrange the pictures to form a single stack. When the stack is complete, two clue phrases can be read in the letters, one starting from each side: ALIAS OF SASQUATCH and MONSTER TRUCK NAME. Both clues lead to the same answer: **BIGFOOT** – a monster often studied by cryptozoologists.

Below we list the contents of each square, along with the associated letters. Parentheses indicate pictures.
