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``Spectra of elements in some group rings''

The analysis of the spectrum of an element of the group ring of SU(2), SL(2,Z),... under finite dimensional irreducible unitary representations, arises in many contexts (in analysis-the Ruziewizc problem, in combinatorics-expanders, in quantization-semi classical theory). One crucial feature is the apparently difficult problem of a spectral gap. For SU(2) the construction of an element with a spectral gap was first carried out by Drinfeld. We give a general and elementary method for achieving such a gap and discuss some other features of the spectra of such elements. This is joint work with Gamburd and Jakobson.
