



Rules of Behavior

These rules are expected to be followed by all students at all times. Read the list, and then sign your name at the bottom.

- Follow all instructions given by the instructor and by any parent supervisor, if there is one.
- While the instructor is talking, LISTEN. Do not talk unless you raise your hand and have been called on.
- Be engaged in the activities of the class: No cell phones, no other homework, and keep any talking relevant to the math being discussed.
- If asked to work quietly, do not disrupt the class by whispering, humming, tapping the table, or otherwise deliberately making noise.
- No running, playing, or shouting, including during break. Remember that it is a privilege to use this space, and if we are disruptive to the customers we will be asked to leave.
- Be respectful of the space. Don't touch anything on the walls, do not open and close doors, and always write on a clipboard or similar surface to avoid damaging the tables.
- Don't complain about the material presented- have a positive attitude!

If you break these rules, you are wasting my time, your own time, and the time of your classmates who have come here to learn interesting math. Failure to behave appropriately will result in a **yellow card**, which serves as an official warning. An email will be sent to your parents.

Repeated violations of these rules may result in you being asked not to attend future math circle meets.
