Exam 2 will cover sections 5.1 to 7.5

The final exam will cover all materials.

The lower of the midterm scores (or a missed midterm) will be replaced by the score on the final exam if it is higher. Beware: the material becomes more difficult as we proceed through the course, so it is in your best interest to do well on each midterm. Missed quizzes and exams count as zero, even if you join the course late or have a legitimate reason for missing the test. **No make-up quizzes or exams.**

Incomplete grades: Incomplete grades are almost never given.
